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WHAT'S the WEB???

The WEB is a place for young people aged 12 to 18 years of age who are attending High School. Our philosophy is to support young people to build better relationships within their community and to provide them with a sense of belonging and with that, responsibility.

The WEB is an important local resource that provides support to all young people and their parents or carers. We can help with advocacy, information, support and guidance.

The youth centre aims to build strong relationships within the community. We invite other youth related services and local businesses who would like to join in providing activities for young people. We believe that in building these relationships it will provide better opportunities for young people and our community.

While attending the WEB young people can access mainstream services such as Doctors and Nurses, Alcohol and other Drug Counsellors and Youth workers all free of charge.

In general we try to provide a place for young people to congregate, socialise, meet new friends, that is cost effective and safe, which assists the engagement of youth into the community.

What's on what days at the WEB

MONDAYS CLOSED

Tuesdays 2pm to 5 pm

- Any teenager can call in!
- Hang out watch TV, play pool or just relax.
- Internet Access (restrictions apply).
- Teenagers may call in and have a chat about anything to do with Alcohol or Other Drugs.

WESNESDAYS 2pm to 6 pm

- Any teenager can call in for a chat or just hang out.
- The WEB Wipe-out (old habits gone) Fitness & Nutrition program 3.30pm at WEB then across to Rogers park.
- We can help with dealing with relationship problems, offering programmes in understanding anger and conflict resolution skills.
- If you're having any problems you can talk to a youth worker about it, if we can't assist you, we will try to find some one who can!

THURSDAYS 2pm to 6 pm

- Any teenager can call in!
- Individual support can be organised on these days.
- Pool comps and other activities.
- Guitar & other musical instruments available
- You can play the games, computers, talk to a youth worker, or relax with friends.

FRIDAYS 2.30 pm to 9.30 pm

- There is a FREE clinic from 4.30pm where you can see a Doctor and a Nurse about any health issue.
- BBQ on the first Friday of every month.
- Theme nights, indoor soccer & movie nights .
- Have a chat with about anything to do with Alcohol or Other Drugs.
- Self Defence classes (Combat Kempo)

SCHOOL HOLIDAYS - normal week day times.

- External & internal activities.
- Occasionally the WEB could be closed on a Tuesday if a group outing has been planned.

Saturdays 5.00pm to 9.30pm

- Activities or just hang out!
- Bring a friend play a game or join in the organized games.
- Daytona's, musical instruments, air-hockey, PS2 games, computers, pool tables, table tennis, karaoke, board games, & much more!

THE WEB'S RULES

- **NO DRUGS OR ALCOHOL, or be under the influence of these substances. They are not allowed in or around the Community Centre.**
- **Must be a member of the WEB, (membership is FREE)**
- **The Co-ordinator reserves the right to ask you to leave or disallow entry at anytime.**

- **Respect all users of the Centre and WEB.**
- **Treat equipment and amusement machines with respect.**
